#### Abstract:

A collection of business records related to the early twentieth-century fishing industry as well as the personal papers of Tokunosuke Abe.

#### **Biographical/Historical Notes:**

Tokunosuke Abe was born in Iwate-Ken, Japan in 1885. After completing high school and marrying, he emigrated to the United States in 1906, arriving first in Seattle before moving to Southern California. He attended the Woodbury Business College in Los Angeles, receiving a degree in accounting and business, and then became secretary at the San Diego Japanese Vegetable Growers Association. In the 1920s, he worked with Kondo Masaharu, president of the Mexican Industrial Development Company, but in 1931 the business's cannery and Turtle Bay operation was expropriated by the Mexican Government. Kondo returned to Japan, leaving Abe with a floundering business depended upon by one hundred fifty contract fishermen.

In 1933, Abe organized the Southern Commercial Company with his brother-in-law Aizumi Kyuji and operations supervisor Miura Koshiro as junior partners. Within five years, the company controlled twenty-five tuna boats, the largest fleet under single management in Southern California. Also during this time period, Abe successfully defended the business against threats of prosecution by the California Fish and Game Commission for hiring Japanese fishermen who were residents of Mexico.

This legal victory saved the tuna fleet for a time, but anti-Japanese sentiment continued to grow over the next several years, and by 1939 there were even more restrictive bills under debate by the California State legislature, which would effectively ban the vast majority of Japanese from the commercial fishing industry. In San Diego, Abe worked with members of the local JACL chapter to raise funds and public support from canneries, fishermen's associations, and local politicians. Though these, too, were eventually defeated, the next year and a half saw increasing animosity toward Japanese fishermen in the lead-up to World War II.

Abe Tokunosuke died on January 3, 1941, before the outbreak of war and destruction of the Japanese tuna fleet of California.

## Scope and Content:

A collection of business records related to the early twentieth-century fishing industry as well as the personal papers of Tokunosuke Abe. The business records include business reports, financial records, inventories, and other records, including files on individual fishing boats (correspondence, crew lists, expenses, etc). The personal papers include investments and other personal finances, correspondence, probate documents, and biographical material written by Donald Estes.
