Abstract:

A collection of anniversary booklets, property documents, photographs, and other documents related to the history of the San Diego Japanese Christian Church (previously called the San Diego Holiness Church).

Biographical/Historical Notes:

In 1923, ministerial student Junro Kashitani of the Los Angeles Holiness Church visited the El Cajon Valley and shared the message of Jesus Christ to Japanese families in the area. The San Diego Holiness Church was officially founded in 1930, after years of monthly services and cottage meetings (*katei shukai*) held by clergymen traveling from Los Angeles to San Diego. They initially met in a rented house on 30th and Newton Streets. Additionally, weekly evangelistic street meetings were held every Saturday night on the corner of Fifth and Island Streets. A permanent church building was acquired in July of 1940 at 3042 Webster Street.

To serve the growing Nisei community, the church developed an English-speaking department in 1951 and permanently relocated to 1920 E Street in 1966 after a rise in membership. The San Diego Holiness Church changed their name to the San Diego Japanese Christian Church in 1981, and its mission today is "to grow in Christ and share the Word of God with all, having special resources to reach Japanese and Asian people."
